NOTICE

In accordance with the provisions of section 131(2) of the Copyright Ordinance, Chapter 528, I hereby give notice that the item(s) listed below was/were seized on 18.12.2024 at 2/F, 39 Staunton Street, Central, in Hong Kong, as being article, vessel, aircraft, vehicle or thing liable to forfeiture under section 131(1) of the said Ordinance:

- 1) One set of karaoke system with touch screen panel;
- 2) One set of amplifier with cable;
- 3) Two sets of speakers with cables;
- 4) One set of microphone system with cable;
- 5) One television remote control;
- 6) Six wireless microphones; and
- 7) One set of television with cable.

Any person as referred to in Section 131(5) of the said Ordinance, may within 30 days beginning –

- (a) on the date of the seizure of the above item(s);
- (b) where this notice is served by delivery to the person to be served, on the date of service; or
- (c) where this notice is sent by registered post, 2 days after the date of posting; or
- (d) on the first day of the exhibition of this notice,

give notice in writing to the Commissioner of his full name and address for service in Hong Kong and claim that the above item(s) is/are not liable to forfeiture.

Explanatory Notes

- (1) Making a claim to the Commissioner of Customs & Excise will not lead to an automatic return of the item(s). Where a valid notice of claim is received, the Commissioner will file an application to court for the forfeiture of the item(s). The court will fix a date for the hearing of such application and will issue a summons to the claimant requiring him to attend the hearing if he is not the defendant in the related criminal proceedings. The result of the application will be determined by the court. In the case where the claimant is the defendant in the related criminal proceedings and there is no other claimant, on an application made in that behalf by the Commissioner, the court may hear the forfeiture application immediately following the criminal proceedings.
- (2) If no notice of claim in writing has been given to the Commissioner of Customs & Excise within the stipulated period of time, the item(s) is forfeited forthwith to the Government.
