香港海關與土耳其當局簽訂AEO互認安排行動計劃

Hong Kong Customs signs Action Plan for AEO Mutual Recognition Arrangement with Turkey

在疫情下,香港海關繼續積極拓展香港認可經濟營 運商(AEO)計劃的互認安排網絡。透過土耳其駐香 港總領事館的協助,香港海關與土耳其貿易部於 2022年1月25日簽訂互認安排行動計劃,正式啟動 兩地互認安排的商討進程。

土耳其作為「一帶一路」地區的經濟體,簽訂這份 互認安排行動計劃,不僅體現了兩地在加強國際貨 物安全方面的決心,亦有助獲認證的香港企業享有 互認安排實施後所賦予的優勢,在「一帶一路」倡 議下更有效地開拓當地的市場。 Amid the pandemic, Hong Kong Customs continues the effort to extend the Mutual Recognition Arrangement (MRA) network of Hong Kong Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) Programme. With the assistance of the Consulate General of Turkey in Hong Kong, Hong Kong Customs signed an MRA Action Plan with the Ministry of Trade of the Republic of Turkey on 25 January 2022, marking the commencement of formal development for mutual recognition of the respective AEO Programmes in two places.

Apart from demonstrating the two administrations' determination to strengthen international cargo security, the signing of the MRA Action Plan with Turkey also enables accredited Hong Kong traders to better explore the market by leveraging their edge of certified status under the Belt and Road Initiative.
